Annual Report for 2018-2019:

The school re-opened for the year 2018-2019 for Classes IV-X on 18th April 2018, on the occasion of Buddha Purnima. Most Revered Amalaprana Mataji, the General Secretary, Sri Sarada Math and Ramakrishna Sarada Mission, inaugurated the new Library building. This was done in the presence of several important dignitaries and Senior Sanyasinis of Sri Sarada Math. Revered General Secretary Mataji, jointly with the Deputy Commissioner, gave away the prizes for 2017-2018 to the children.

On 2nd May, Students of Class IX and Class X performed the Vidyarthini Homa. Revered General Secretary Mataji was the Acharya. On 3rd May, a Managing Committee meeting was held at the Deputy Commissioner's Chamber, Bomdila.

On 4th May, the Honorable Chief Minister of Arunachal Pradesh, Shri Pema Khandu, inaugurated the new school block, Vivek Bhavan in the presence of the Union Minister of State (Home Affairs) Shri Kiren Rijiju and MLA, Dirang and Parliamentary Secretary (Health and Family Welfare) Shri Phurpa Tsering and other dignitaries. School Teaching Methodology and Achievements:

Ramakrishna Sarada Mission Girls' School, Dirang has made a humble beginning at unravelling the latent talent and potential of the students. Apart from Classroom instruction, following the Central Board of Secondary Education Syllabus; the school regularly conducts internal events and competitions to help the child identify their core interests and future areas of pursuit.

Periodic Internal Assessments and Terminal Examinations evaluate the child's academic progress, while the co-scholastic activities such as Debate, Extempore, Recitation, Essay Writing, Song and Dance Competitions, Sports Competitions and similar events aim to develop a self-confident, multi-faceted student with a strong foundation in moral and ethical values. Students participate in competitions and attend events conducted by other institutions as well such as ICAR-Yak, Krishi Vigyan Kendra, National Science Museum and other District and State Level Departments, winning prizes in various events.

This has provided the students exposure to and opportunity to interact with other students, thereby building their self-confidence and social skills.

The children are exposed to the teachings of Sri Sri Ramakrishna, Sri Ma Sarada Devi and Swami ji, with focus on Swami Vivekananda's philosophy of man-making and character building education.
